Missionary Offering

The offering this month is for Derek and Heidi Malcolm and their family who, while living in Glasgow, are serving on behalf of the church in Turkish speaking lands. The following information comes directly from Derek himself.

Dear friends at Westwoodhill,

We want to thank you for your continued prayers for us and for your practical support. We appreciate that very much. For many years now you have followed our work and we are very grateful for your fellowship in the Gospel. Heidi and her colleagues continue to reach out to the community in Glasgow. While this work is slow and often difficult, there are encouraging signs of interest too. Heidi now has a number of people who phone her and invite her to visit them, which is a sure sign of trust being built up. Heidi often has opportunities to pray with them and to share her faith. We sometimes smile at God's ways. Heidi is doing the same work here in Glasgow that she did while abroad.

Derek is busy with the Christian publishing ministry and is working to produce a full set of Bible commentaries for the Turkish church. Most books of the Bible as yet do not have a single Bible commentary. The commentaries being produced are the Bible Speaks Today series published by IVP. These are proving to be very helpful resources for local Bible teachers and church leaders. Derek's next trip to Istanbul is planned for the end of May. We'd appreciate prayer for the trip and that he would be a real encouragement to the church there.

We were both in Frankfurt last weekend, ministering at a conference for colleagues like us working among the same people as us but in Germany, Austria and Switzerland. Heidi translated into German for Derek. This was a very encouraging time where we could all share together, talk about new resources and generally get a bigger picture of what God is doing throughout Europe among the people we reach out to. The work is still very small and we wonder when there will be a breakthrough. Please continue to pray, especially for the land of Turkey at this time.
