The **Missionary Offering** this month is for Andy Silver and the Pop Connection Team and their work in schools around the country. Andy reports that during 2011 the team ran projects in 66 schools and their communities. As each school averaged around 200 pupils approximately 13,220 children had the experience of singing and performing Pop Connection songs. In addition to this each concert had an attendance of anything from 150 to 400 parents, teachers and friends so not only the children but thousands of adults have been impacted with the truth of Jesus and the joy of hearing the children perform.

During the past year Andy has had meetings with Govt ministers, MPs and the leaders of numerous education authorities, schools and churches. They even had a concert broadcast live on Yorkshire TV evening news. These meetings are vital in keeping the doors open into schools as secularism increases and Head Teachers become more wary of allowing external Christian groups into their schools. We are asked to pray that Pop Connection will continue to find favour with Head Teachers and Education Authorities and that God will open up many new opportunities for them to show His light and Truth into schools and communities throughout the country. Andy and the team are looking forward to being with us here in EK in March and thank us for our much appreciated and valued prayers and financial support.
